

11. Annual fee of Rs. 4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2011 to 31.03.2014) be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.).
12. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee of Rs. 25,000/- and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.
13. The school is eligible to open CBSE pattern classes XI w.e.f. 01.04.2011. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class XII of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2013.
14. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.
15. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-
- The school is required to appoint PGTs in the concerned subjects.
 - The school is required to furnish a copy of EPF challan of last month.
 - The school should pay salary and other allowances at par with corresponding categories employees of the state Govt./centre Govt. and submit acquaintance roll for the last three months alongwith bankers certificate from the bank that the salary to the staff is being paid through bank with single cheque advice.
 - The school should send its teacher for various in service courses/workshops/ Public seminars conducted by the CBSE or other reputed institution to enrich their Knowledge.
 - The school is required to provide proper sanitation in the Toilets.

Other Conditions:-

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months of issue of sanction letter:-

1. Running starting of Class IX/X or XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level, Sr. Secondary from the Board would be unauthorised and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non submission of application for extension of Provisional Affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to that by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye Law.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE at school building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/Trust to a Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation immediate effect.
5. Pay & Allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and Staff be given appointment/confir letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Man Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV.
8. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-) Sr. Secondary (XI-XII).
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of women from sexual harassment at the work place abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No. 666 1992 Vishakha and others state of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13/08/1997.
10. Rs. 4501/- on account of annual fee for 3 years may please be remitted.

With reference to your application dated **21.06.2008** and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for **Senior School Certificate Examination** for a period of three years w.e.f. **01.04.2011** to **31.03.2014** in the following subjects:-

(a) **Languages:- ENGLISH CORE/ELECTIVE, HINDI CORE/ELECTIVE.**

(b) **Elective Subjects:- HISTORY, GEOGRAPHY, ECONOMICS, MATHEMATICS, PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, BIOLOGY, COMPUTER SCIENCE, HOME SCIENCE, PHYSICAL EDUCATION, BUSINESS STUDIES, ACCOUNTANCY.**

The sanction is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:-

1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
2. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
3. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
4. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.
5. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.

 1. Boundary Wall: Concrete boundary wall of not less than 6 ft. height, enclosing the school campus/site. Composite boundary walls which are partly concrete and partly grill/mesh/barbed wire below 6 feet will not be acceptable. If fencing/grill is required, then the same should be over and above 6 feet height.
 2. Ramps at the entrance(s) as well as Ramps/lifts for CWSN, to access the upper floors of the school (in case of a multistoried school) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).

3. Separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor (in case of multistoried schools) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
4. Appropriate laboratory infrastructure for Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab) and for Senior Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab, Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab.) (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
